BUILDING WORK UPDATE: At St John Vianney's, the broken church windows and frames overlooking Park Road will be replaced shortly. At St Cuthbert's a new and sustainable church heating system will be installed soon. Costing surveys are well-underway on St Cuthbert's church so as to put together a programme of works for its much-needed repair and restoration including most importantly - the Rose Window. This will be a massive, complex and protracted project given that St Cuthbert's is a historic church and so conservation regulations strictly apply. Such a project will, of course, have major ramifications on parish finances and energies. Thank you for your support.
