LENT 2020:

BLACKPOOL DEANERY STATION MASSES: Our next Deanery Station Mass will take place this Wednesday at 12noon (18th March) at Holy Family. Following this, these Wednesday Masses will be celebrated on 25th March at Our Lady of the Assumption and on 1st April at St Kentigern's – both at 12noon. These Masses are supposed to take the place of individual parish Masses across the Deanery on these dates.

THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS are publicly celebrated in Lent after the 10.00am Mass on Friday at St Cuthbert's and at 3.30pm on Sundays before Benediction at St John Vianney's. All are welcome!

BEHOLD 2020: REDEDICATION OF ENGLAND

TRIDUUM OF PRAYER: In preparation for the Rededication of England as the Dowry of Mary, our two parishes will come together at St Cuthbert's for the three consecutive evenings leading up to 29th March. This Triduum will be held on Thursday 26th March at 6.00pm, Friday 27th March at 6.00pm and concluding on Saturday 28th March at 5.00pm. On these evenings, our prayers will be accompanied by a Sermon and conclude with Benediction. All are most welcome!

REDEDICATION OF ENGLAND AS THE DOWRY OF MARY: On the weekend of Saturday 28th/ Sunday 29th March, we will be joining with Catholics all across the country for the Rededication of England as Mary's Dowry.
